Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 06 (02 section each for Bal Vatika 1, 2 and 3 respectively). The total number of sections from classes I to XII shall be restricted to 26, of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. Further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq. ft. dimension. The number of students in each class shall be restricted to 40.
2	Ramp/lift to access upper floors is not available. Further, the ramp at entrance has been overlaid on stairs and appears to be made of iron sheet, which is steep and slippery. As school vide letter dated 02.12.2023 uploaded on SARAS portal has informed that management committee has passed the resolution on 29.09.2023 to arrange the lift/ramp to access the upper floors and the work will be initiated shortly, school is hereby directed to ensure completion of construction of ramp to access upper floors and to dismantle the existing ramp on ground floor and re-construct it with proper gradient, as per the provision laid in RPWD Act and Board's guidelines (https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05_2023.pdf) within 03 months and submit compliance.
3	The school does not seem to have referred to RPwD Act and guidelines of the Board for CwSN toilets. Regular cubicles have been converted into CwSN toilets, which are too small and narrow for free movement of wheelchair/walker. The building is G+1,

	but 1 CWSN toilet each for boys and girls are seen in the video. School has pasted paper printouts, instead of permanent signage at the entrance of the CWSN toilet. The School shall construct CWSN toilets separately for boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage, indicating the floor number and with all infrastructural facilities, as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines of the Board within 03 months and submit the compliance with videography.
4	The school has set-up the composite science lab on the wooden tables. The school shall upgraded the same as per Board's SoP with proper stone/metal topped work stations and permanent fixture, washbasin, water & gas connection in the workstations, storage facilities, seating arrangement and safety features such as fire extinguishers and exhaust fan within 03 months and submit the compliance with videography.
5	The general upkeep of campus is not upto the mark The playground has not been properly maintained. Wild grass is growing haphazardly in the field (Re-uploaded video reference time 5:40). The school is required to maintain the playground, improve the general upkeep and submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on the SARAS portal.
6	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Chennai within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the academic session i.e. 2024-25.
